SKILL LEVEL

Easy

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

12 x 25"/31 x 64cm circumference

MATERIALS + TOOLS

- Lion Brand Moonlight Mohair (57% acrylic, 28% mohair, 9% cotton, 6% metallic polyester; 1.75oz/50g = 82yds/75m): 2 skeins, color Safari #510-203—approx 164yds/150m of bulky-weight yarn 
- Knitting needles: 10mm (size 15 U.S.) or size needed to obtain gauge

- Crochet hook 5mm (size H-8 U.S.) or darning needle
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

- 11 sts = 4"/10cm worked on 10mm (size 15 U.S.) needles in lace pattern
- Gauge is not critical for this project since the stitch is loose and lacy.

Instructions

CO 34 sts.

Row 1 Knit.

Row 2 Purl.

Row 3 *K1, yo, k2tog; rep from

* across, end k1.

Although the pattern looks like a complicated ribbed lace, this romantic design is actually simple enough for even beginners to knit.

Row 4

Purl.
Rep Rows 3 and 4 for lace pattern until piece measures 25"/64cm from beg, or to desired length.

BO.

Finish

Using a tapestry needle, sew the long edges together to form a tube; or if you prefer, use a crochet hook to slip stitch the seam together. Weave in yarn ends.
