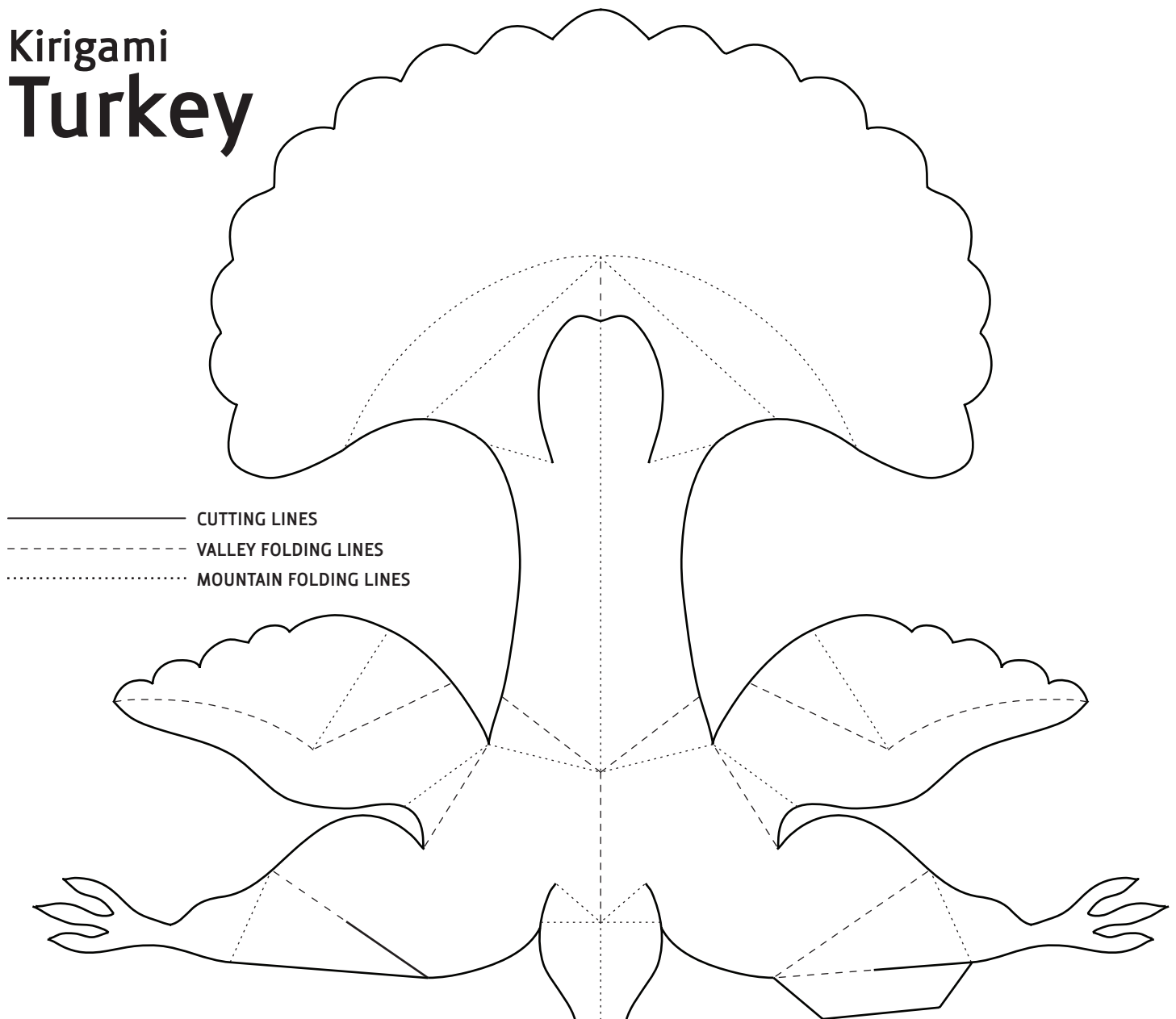
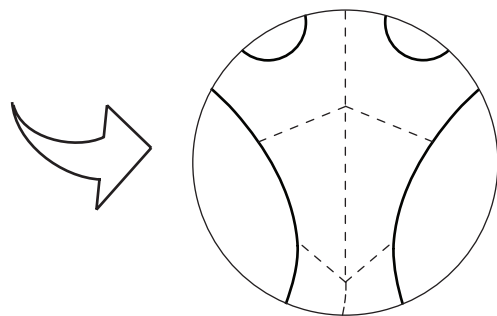


# Kirigami Turkey



## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Score the folding (dotted) lines and cut the template along the solid lines, including the lines of the eyes and the tail.
2. Fold along the scored lines, correctly following mountain folds and valley folds. Work on the head first. Pinch and shape the "snood" so that it hangs naturally from the beak.
3. Work on the neck next. Follow the folding lines and make the neck stand up right.
4. Fold the top half of the body in half along the spine, then lower half towards the tail by pushing down the center.
5. Add roundness to 2 halves of the chest. Pull them together in front and interlock the cut joints, aligning the triangles in the middle.
6. Fold both legs over so that the feet will face forward.
7. Study the photograph of the finished project and shape the wings. Then tuck the roots of the wings behind the chest.
8. Shape the tail according to the folding lines. Add the natural curve to the whole tail feathers. Fine tune the angle of the tail by adjusting the folds at the tail's root, so that it will look right from all angles.
